

2010 Pet Foods with "Medicinal Purpose"

Iams Veterinary Formulas

86 Ill. Adm. Code 130.2165 requires veterinary practices to: "... annually obtain a letter from the manufacturer representing that the animal food is only sold to licensed veterinarians. Provided that a veterinarian maintains this letter in his or her books and records, the Department shall consider the food to have a 'medicinal purpose' for the period of one year following the date of issuance of the letter."

The ISVMA has obtained permission from the Department of Revenue to collect the required letters from the food manufacturers, maintain them in our records for reference, maintain and publish a compiled list that can be used as a resource for tax purposes. This list of foods considered to have a "medicinal purpose" is available only to ISVMA members on the ISVMA website.

The following list of products have been confirmed by Rachael L. Yates of The Iams Company/P&G Pet Care on February 8, 2010 as items which are prescription items and only sold through veterinarians.
