

### Dr. Dawn Logas, DVM

Dawn Logas received her Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Florida in 1982 and then was accepted into the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine finishing her Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M.) in 1986. She was in small animal practice for 3 years in San Antonio, Texas before returning to Ocala, FL where she began her dermatology residency at the University of Florida. After completing her residency, she stayed on part-time as assistant professor of dermatology until 1998. She founded the Veterinary Dermatology Center in Winter Park, FL in 1993 and continues to practice medicine.

Dr. Logas is a frequent author and speaker on dermatology and has served on the Executive Board of the American College of Veterinary Dermatology from 2006-2014 and also served as the two years as the President.

Her special interests in dermatology are: allergic disease, ear disease, topical therapy and nutritional therapy.

Dr. Patrick earned his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree from the University of Illinois in 1999. After graduation, he went into mixed animal practice as an associate veterinarian in Waterloo, IL.
