

Welcome to Power of 10!

The Concept

Power of 10 is an ISVMA initiative designed to help recent graduates develop fundamental skills in leadership, communication and business. This year, we will also be providing the opportunity for mid-career DVMs (8-25 years from graduation) to strengthen these skills—presentations will be targeted to the needs of each career group. It also provides each participant with 20 hours of continuing education (four hours per session) at NO COST!

How It Works

Ten participants for each of the two groups—recent graduates and midcareer veterinarians--will be selected from the applicant pool to participate in the Power of 10 leadership academy. Participants will join a network of peers in a series of learning experiences that commence in September 2018 and culminate in April 2019. Power of 10 is a pathway to help veterinarians answer questions like:

- I emerged from veterinary school and am in practice—but how can I get a better grasp on what makes me tick? How do my goals change as my career progresses?
- Now that I have a technical staff, how can I form, manage, and lead an effective team?
- Who am I in the bigger picture, and what can I give to my family, my community and my profession that will be my legacy?
- > How do I plan for my financial future, and that of my practice?

The Power of 10 class creates a sense of community and participants build lasting bonds with other members of the leadership academy class. Teambuilding activities with each session help promote these relationships.

In-person learning experiences are scheduled to minimize the impact on working hours—and the entire program is designed to garner support from practice owners and managers who recognize their key responsibility in developing human resources.

The Cost

Participants will receive full tuition scholarships to the program. ISVMA will provide a meal, coaches and the curriculum team for each learning experience. Participants are responsible for their own lodging, if needed, and for transportation to all programs. Limited gas and lodging scholarships may be available.

Key Benefits

Through the Power of 10, participants will:

- Develop a fundamental understanding of leadership skills and emotional intelligence
- Deepen comprehensive communications styles
- Acquire skills to become the leaders they envision themselves to be
- Gain the competency to utilize these skills within their lives, practices and communities
- Acquire critical skills to intensify business acumen
- Improve their understanding of personal and business finance
- Experience a supportive environment that fosters meaningful interpersonal relationships and collaborative, lifelong interactions
- Heighten self-awareness and better understand how to maximize interactions with those around them
