Stephanie Keating, DVM, DVSc, DACVAA

University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine, Urbana, IL

Dr. Keating received her veterinary degree from the Ontario Veterinary College (OVC) in 2009. She joined a small animal practice in the Toronto area before returning to the OVC where she completed her residency and Doctor of Veterinary Science graduate degree in veterinary anesthesiology and analgesia in 2013. Dr. Keating also has an interest in the well-being of laboratory animals and received certification in laboratory animal medicine from the University of Guelph, Canada.

She became a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Anesthesia and Analgesia in 2014. Dr. Keating worked in small animal private referral practice in Toronto as an anesthesiologist for several years before joining the anesthesia team at the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine, where she has been for more than nine years.

She is currently a Clinical Associate Professor and has been the head of the anesthesia service for more than seven years. There, Dr. Keating enjoys teaching, research and managing a diverse and complex clinical caseload.

Opioids are the cornerstone for perioperative analgesia but may not be sufficient as a sole analgesic. Opioids are also not often a viable option for outpatient pain management. In this session, we will discuss the concept of “multimodal analgesia” and discuss a variety of non-opioid analgesic treatments that can be used to optimize pain management in patients, both in and out of the clinic.

Guidelines

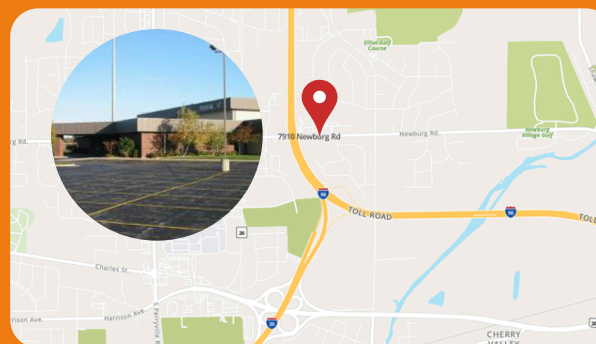
